THEMES AND GOALS OF THE EVENT:

The current Covid-19 pandemic has forced students and academics to switch to online teaching modes. Thus the process of digitalisation in higher education has evolved rapidly. In 2020, the European Commission published a special call for proposals for Strategic Partnerships focusing on digitalisation, inviting universities and other stakeholders to prepare and submit digitalisation projects. Digitalization is visible in different areas of HEIs' activities: teaching, research, serving to society, internal management. This was expressed in the submitted proposals.

During the seminar, we would like to:

- invite participants to share lessons learnt so far from implementation of “digitalisation driven” projects,
- discuss with the participants and experts what digital university should look like,
- analyse which kinds of knowledge and skills can be taught online, and
- check how universities address the challenges of changing the learning process in the digital era.

Exchange of good practices and recommendations for HEIs how to prepare University for challenges related with digitalisation of HEIs and new modes of online teaching and learning.

SPEAKERS - SESSION AT 12:00 - 13:30

Beata Skibińska since 1991 has been involved in the administration of educational programmes. In 1991-2000 worked for the National TEMPUS Office in Poland (starting from responsibility for Individual Mobility Grants, through Joint European Projects, becoming vice-coordinator of the programme). Since 1999 acting as a person responsible for the Erasmus programme (higher education) in Poland. At present Director for Higher Education Department in the National Agency for the programmes Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps.

Ivana Juraga is a Policy Officer in the Digital Education Unit of Directorate-General for Education, Youth, Sport and Culture of the European Commission. Her duties involve work on the enabling factors for successful digital education, strengthening the evidence gathering and analysis on digital education, and following the digital transformation in higher education. Ivana holds degrees from the University of Zagreb and the London School of Economics and Political Science. She has previously worked at the Croatian Agency for Adult Education, the Croatian Ministry of Science, Education and Sports, and the European University Association.

Dorota Kamińska received her Ph.D. degree from the Faculty of Electrical, Electronic, Computer, and Control Engineering at the Lodz University of Technology in Poland in 2014. She was part of the TOP 500 Innovators program at Haas School of Business, University of California in Berkeley in 2015. Currently, she is an educator and researcher at the Institute of Mechatronics and Information Systems. She is the founder and leader of the Voxel Research Lab, focusing her academic pursuits on cutting-edge VR and AR applications. She has received several national and European Research grants and is coordinating and taking part in many Erasmus+ projects. In 2021, the Polish Erasmus+ National Agency awarded her the first prize in the Digitalization category of the competition „Eduinspiracje” (educational inspirations) for the ViMeLa project (Strategic Partnership).

Maciej Pietrzykowski, PhD, researcher and academic teacher at Poznan University of Economics and Business in Poland, at the Department of International Competitiveness, senior consultant and business trainer, entrepreneur. Grant Holder and Project Coordinator of many international projects from Leonardo da Vinci and Erasmus + Programmes. Certified project manager in Prince 2 methodology (Practitioner level). PUEB Programme Director of the Erasmus Mundus Programme: Transition, Innovation and Sustainability Environments. Alumni of Poznań University of Economics and Business and governmental TOP 500 Innovators Programme at University of California, Berkeley, Hass School of Business.

Igor Balaban, PhD., is Associate Professor at Faculty of Organization and Informatics at the University of Zagreb in Croatia, Vice-dean for science, international cooperation and projects, and Head of Laboratory for advanced technologies in e-learning. He was actively involved in a dozen of European and national projects and currently coordinates two Erasmus+ Key Action 2 projects: AMED and Teach4Edu4. His main field of interest is technology supported learning with special focus on adaptivity and personalization in learning environments and digital transformation of educational organizations. He also has a traceable scientific record in assessing the successful implementation of information systems.

Marta Materska - Samek, PhD., Assistant professor at the Department of Management, Media Economics and Advertising of the Jagiellonian University in Poland, researcher and experienced manager of research and development projects, expert in the film industry and regional, national and European funds. Reviewer and author of publications in the field of cultural and creative industries, pro-innovation policies and financing the development of the creative sector. She lectures on strategic media management, entrepreneurship, new trends in management, as well as issues of culture and media economics. Laureate of the Doctus Małopolski program, scholarship holder of the Government of the French Republic, Scholarship and Training Fund and the Polish Ministry of Culture and National Heritage in the field of culture management.

Agata Komendant - Brodowska, PhD., is a sociologist working at the University of Warsaw, passionate about using models and simulations to study social processes. She coordinated the process of creating and implementing a new MA programme 'Digital Sociology' at the Faculty of Sociology. Leader of an Erasmus+ ACTISS project (actiss-edu.eu): Action for Computational Thinking in Social Sciences.
